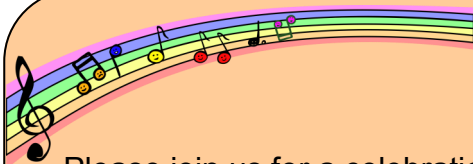
## **CHANGES TO DINNER REQUIREMENTS**
