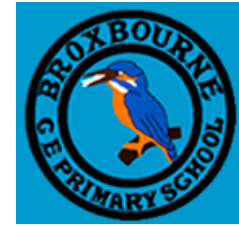
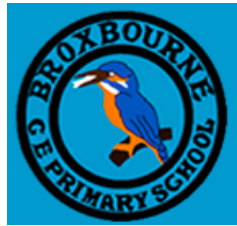

Year 3 Curriculum

- Outline for the term is available through the Curriculum overviews on the school website.
- **Science: Animals including humans, including nutrition. Forces and Magnets.**
- **RE: Understanding Christianity resource- focus on Gospel. Current Value of Justice.**
- **History and Geography: Pre-history: life in Britain during the Stone Age and Bronze Age.**
- **Computing: Programming and Games. ICT skills e.g. copy and paste, crop and print screen etc.**
- We are continuing to focus on a 'recovery curriculum'- ensuring that the children are emotionally ready for learning and school whilst recapping key skills missed from the previous years.
- Growth Mind-set- becoming independent learners, challenge themselves.

PE

- Will take place on Monday and Wednesday.
- PE kits to remain in school until half term.
- Each half term I will send a parent mail/message on Google Classroom detailing activities and kit required for these activities.
- This half term: Yoga (Monday) and Football (Wednesday).
- Yoga: PE kit (white t-shirt, shorts, white socks and plimsolls).
- Football: long sleeved rugby style top, shorts/joggers, long blue socks, shin pads, football boots and trainers (in case football cannot take place).
- Trainers and carrier bag are needed every Friday for the Daily Mile.

Homework and Timetables

- Homework will continue to be set on Google Classroom.
- Set on a Thursday and handed in on a Tuesday.
- Sometimes the homework will need to be completed in a homework exercise book. This will be sent home on Thursday.
- Whole school approach: Mathletics, spellings including rule and 5 common exception words and a reading activity.
- I will create an overview sheet which clearly explains all homework and activities. This will be uploaded onto the Class stream.
- Spelling test on a Tuesday.
- Timetables practice as much as possible each day/week
- Weekly timetable test on a Friday to begin 17th September.

Timetable Test Year 4

- Children will be tested using an on-screen check where they will have to answer multiplication questions against the clock.
- Children will have 6 seconds to answer each question.
- There are 25 questions.
- Questions will be selected from the 121 number facts that make up the multiplication tables from 2 to 12, with a particular focus on the 6, 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables as they are considered to be the most challenging.
- Children will be given the opportunity to practise answering questions in this format before the official check begins.

Reading

- Every night (minimum 5 times) with comment in their reading record. This can be reading with an adult/sibling/relative.
- Reading for pleasure and levelled reading.
- Levelled books are changed on a Monday.
- Reading for pleasure can include any genre, listening to audio books, reading recipes etc.
- Whole Class Guided Reading twice weekly.
- Reading Fluency Group.
- Class Story- BFG/Nothing to see here hotel.
- Reading levels and bands are checked each every half term.
- Focus on comprehension skills- What do you think will happen next? Why do you think this? Using evidence from the book to justify their thinking.
- Focus on 'Inference'
